New Franklinton High School Ribbon Cutting and Dedication Ceremony Set for August 18

The faculty and staff of Franklinton High School, in conjunction with the leadership team of the Franklin County Schools Central Office, is hosting a ribbon cutting and dedication ceremony of the new Franklinton High School campus at 910 Cedar Creek Road in Franklinton on Thursday, August 18, 2011 at 5:30 p.m.

Joe Baisley, Public Information Officer for the school district, has been working very hard to put the event together along with Assistant Superintendent for Auxiliary Services Tommy Piper. "We are very excited about this event," Baisley said. "With Mr. Piper's guidance, we are planning the dedication program similar to the one given when the old campus on North Main Street was dedicated on September 11, 1924."

The program will begin with the rising of flags outside of the school's main entrance and the signing of the national anthem. Attendees will then move into the school's auditorium for the rest of the program, which will include various speakers and more. Following the dedication program, a ribbon cutting will take place at the grand staircase to the academic hall.

Attendees will also have the privilege after the ribbon cutting to tour the beautiful campus. This campus would not have been possible if it was not for the 2008 bond referendum voted upon by the citizens of Franklin County.
