
Franklin County Animal Control Adoption Event – November 5, 2011

General information – The event will run from 10am – 2pm. The regular \$25 adoption fee will be waived for animals, however the \$50 spay/neuter deposit will still be collected. Animals will receive their rabies injection prior to adoption if they are old enough. Adopters must have the animal spayed or neutered within 30 days of the adoption and must provide proof of the spay/neuter to Animal Control.

Volunteer duties

Greeter – Greet the public and welcome them to the event. Let them know this event is hosted by the Franklin County Animal Control staff and all proceeds from the event will benefit the shelter. Find out if they are looking for a particular animal and point them in the correct direction. If they have any questions about Animal Control, help them find an officer who can address the questions. Tell them about the free food and the raffle tickets for the trailer.

Animal Handlers – You will be assigned one or two animals to look after. Please try to learn as much as you can about the animal's personality so you can answer any questions. If an individual or family is interested in the animal, please take the animal to a private area, either the adoption room or the fenced yard, so the people can spend some time with the animal. If the animal begins exhibiting any behavior that you feel may be dangerous, immediately stop the interaction and alert an animal control officer. If the individual or family decides to adopt the animal, contact an animal control officer and they will complete the adoption process.
